- 5. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Town Hall, Hall Quay, Great Yarmouth, NR30 2QF by 5 p.m. on Tuesday, 05 December 2023.
- 6. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5 p.m. on Tuesday, 12 December 2023. - 7. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Town Hall, Hall Quay, Great Yarmouth, NR30 2QF by 5 p.m. on Tuesday, 12 December 2023.
- 8. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Town Hall, Hall Quay, Great Yarmouth, NR30 2QF by 5 p.m. on Wednesday, 20 December 2023.
